### Mandatory Fees Definitions

All students enrolled in 6 or more credit hours, including Master's Thesis and PhD students on reduced registration, during the fall and/or spring semester shall pay all semester fees. Students enrolled in Summer Session I or Summer Session II shall pay the fees specified regardless of the credit hours for which they are enrolled. Mines students attending colleges outside the United States as well as Mines employees will be assessed the Technology Fee only.

All students including non-degree, high school, and community college students will be assessed mandatory fees based on the number of credit hours taken:

Credit Hours per Semester	Fees
1.0 – 2.5	Technology Fee, Student Services Fee
3.0 – 5.5	Technology Fee, Student Services Fee, Academic Construction Fee
6.0 +	All Mandatory Fees

Any such student, however, wishing to take part in student activities and receive student privileges may do so by paying full fees. Semester fees are as follows:

The Academic Facilities Construction Fee is a mandatory fee for the purpose of constructing new institutional facilities, and/or renovating, expanding, and maintaining existing institutional facilities that are core to the role and mission of the institution.

The Associated Students Fee is a mandatory fee supporting the activity/functions of Student Government (USG and GSG).

The Intercollegiate Athletics Fee is a mandatory fee allocated to the intercollegiate athletics programs. This allows student access to the athletic facilities during normal operating hours and includes entrance to all intercollegiate sports events.

The Intermodal Transportation Fee is a mandatory fee which support intermodal transportation initiatives. Initiatives include, but are not limited to: an RTD College Pass, a local Golden/Mines Circulator Bus, and other transit demand management issues determined by the Student Government.

The Recreation Center Fee is a mandatory fee that provides support for Recreational Sports operations. Related programs and services include but are not limited to: Intramurals, Club Sports, Fitness, the Outdoor Rec. Center, aquatics, current and future facility operations expenses. A portion of this fee may also be used for construction, renovation, maintenance, staffing, and bond indebtedness of any facility utilized in the execution of Rec. Sports programs or activities.

The Student Health Services Fee is a mandatory fee that provides support for health and wellness related activities, including but not limited to, wellness promotions, alcohol and drug education, sexual assault prevention, counseling activities, health center operations, staff salaries, and contract health services. A portion of this fee is used for construction, renovation, maintenance, and bond indebtedness of health and wellness facilities.

The Student Services Fee is a mandatory fee that provides support for some of the operational activities of the Division of Student Life and the Student Center. A portion of this fee is used to retire the bond indebtedness of the Student Center.

The Technology Fee is a mandatory fee collected for the purpose of providing or purchasing equipment or programmatic activities relating to computer equipment, laboratory equipment, or other technology.

Students could be required to pay additional mandatory fees in addition to semester fees. These can include, but are not limited to, course fees, student orientation fees, and student health insurance fees. Please refer to this academic year's Fees and Charges list.

#### **Summer Session**

Academic summer sessions may at times require fees be assessed to enrolled students. These special fees may include, but are not limited to, the following:

Room and board fees for off-campus lodging, Class material/tools, Costs of external laboratory analysis.

The cost of these services vary from year to year and the academic department makes decisions regarding summer session structure subsequent to the deadlines outlined in the Board of Trustees approved Institutional Plan for Student Fees and Other Charges. The Board shall approve such special summer session fees in principle, subject to the review and approval of the President prior to student assessment.

## Colorado School of Mines Tuition and Fees Refund Policy

The amount of tuition and fee assessments is based primarily on each student's enrolled courses. In the event a student withdraws from a course or courses, assessments will be adjusted as follows:

- If withdrawal from a course or courses is made prior to the end of the add/drop period for the term of enrollment, as determined by the Registrar, tuition and fees will be adjusted to the new course level without penalty.
- If withdrawal from a course or courses is made after the add/drop period, regardless of whether or not the student officially withdraws from Mines, no adjustments in charges will be made.

**Notes:**

- Students receiving federal financial aid under the Title IV programs may have a different refund as required by federal law or regulations.
- Room and board refunds are pro-rated to the date of checkout from the Residence Hall. Arrangements must be made with the Housing Office.
- Student health insurance charges are not refundable. The insurance remains in effect for the entire semester.
